3) Purpose of the sharing	Legal Obligation
4) The Lawfulness Conditions and Special Categories	The processing of personal data in the delivery of the medicines management function is supported under Articles 6 and 9 of the General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR). Article 6(1)(e) ‘...necessary for the performance of a task carried out in the public interest or in the exercise of official authority...’. Article 9(2)(h) processing is necessary for the purposes of preventive or occupational medicine, for the assessment of the working capacity of the employee, medical diagnosis, the provision of health or social care or treatment or the management of health or social care systems and services on the basis of Union or Member State law or pursuant to contract with a health professional and subject to the conditions and safeguards referred to in paragraph 3;

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5) Recipient or categories of recipients of the shared data	The data may be shared with GP Practices or those: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• directly involved in your NHS care• reviewing your NHS care• with a legal right to it• who you have given us permission to share with
6) Rights to object	You have the right under Article 21 of the GDPR to object to your personal information being processed. Please contact the CCG if you wish to object to the processing of your data. You should be aware that this is a right to raise an objection which is not the same as having an absolute right to have your wishes granted in every circumstance. CCGs process personal data under Article 6(1)(c) on a lawful and legitimate basis. Where the organisation is obliged under law to process personal data, the CCG usually has compelling legitimate grounds for that processing which may override the interests, rights and freedoms in the right to object.
7) Right to access and correct	You have the right to access any identifiable data that is being shared and have any inaccuracies corrected.
8) Retention period	The data will be retained for the period as specified in the national records retention schedule.
9) Right to Complain.
