

# Extended GP access service procurement



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- Camden CCG has re-procured its extended GP access service contract.
- The service will provide extra GP appointments to Camden registered patients from 6.30-8pm on Mondays to Fridays and from 8am-8pm on Saturdays and Sundays.
- The aim is to make it easier for people to see a GP at a time convenient to them.
- The procurement process was carried out together with the other North Central London (NCL) CCGs to ensure that all patients across NCL have equitable access to a GP.
- However, only GPs (or collaborations of GPs) already delivering Camden GP services could bid for the Camden contract.



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- Following a robust and fair process, Camden CCG has awarded the Camden contract to the GP-led AT Medics.
- AT Medics run King's Cross Surgery at St Pancras Hospital and similar 8-8 GP services in Lambeth, Croydon and Hammersmith and Fulham.
- The decision was based on the recommendation of the Camden procurement panel which included non-conflicted clinicians, a local patient and Healthwatch Camden.
- AT Medics will co-design the Camden service with local patients and GPs. They will discuss this process with you shortly.

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- The launch date for the service is still being agreed but likely to be in Autumn 2017.
- Haverstock Healthcare will continue to provide an extended GP access service in Camden until it launches.
- Haverstock Healthcare and AT Medics have committed to work closely to ensure a smooth transition and no disruption for patients.
